The story so far...

The Baw Baw Big Blokes Inc. committee works year-round to prepare for this event and ensure that funds raised are directed to causes that make a genuine difference. This year's lunch marks the twelfth event, and across its eleven-year history it has raised an incredible **\$1,905,000** for men's health and other community initiatives.

Supporting Prostate Cancer Research

- In 2025, a further **\$50,000** was donated to the **Prostate Cancer Foundation of Australia (PCFA)**, bringing the total contribution since 2012 to **\$810,000**.
- An additional **\$10,000** was donated to support Linton Blackwell's PCFA-backed **'The Long Run'** fundraiser.
- These funds are helping young researchers at PCFA work towards a cure for prostate cancer.

Youth Programs and Training

- Between 2013 and 2024, every Year 9 student in the Baw Baw Shire, over 8,800 students, completed a Level 1 First Aid course funded by Baw Baw Big Blokes Inc.
- In 2025, Baw Baw Big Blokes Inc. continued its support for Live4Life Baw Baw, delivering youth mental health training in local secondary schools.

Local Men's Health Initiatives

- **2023** – Supported a prostate cancer clinic in Warragul and purchased a bladder scanner for early detection of urological issues.
- **2024 & 2025** – Donated to the **West Gippsland Suicide Support Group**, which provides connection and support for those who have lost a loved one to suicide.
- **2025** – Supplied **'Blokes Business' care packages** to West Gippsland Healthcare Group for patients in hospital and those receiving outpatient and community care.
- **2025** – Donated a **patient sling hoist** to West Gippsland Hospital, improving care for patients with limited mobility.
- **2025** – Formed a **landmark partnership with Mindfull Aus**, committing to deliver a comprehensive range of mental health programs across Baw Baw Shire.

Recognition

In 2024, Baw Baw Big Blokes BBQ was named **'Community Event of the Year'** at the Baw Baw Shire Australia Day Awards.
