

Baw Baw Big Blokes BBQ – October 18, 2019 Sponsorship Packages

Both papers are 'must read' for the vast majority of the community from Bunyip in the West to Trafalgar East in the east, Poowong to the south and Noojee to the north. The Gazette boasts the highest non-daily paid circulation of any newspaper in regional Victoria.

In addition to the press campaign 1000 stubby holders are made for the event promoting patrons and major sponsors that are fast becoming collector items as we change the format and design each year. We also have program booklets for every person that attends the event that lists the program, auction items and sponsor information.

Of course we have some 8000 raffle tickets produced for the event also that promotes all levels of sponsors and the President's speech at the launch night and the event includes naming and thanking sponsors along with MC references throughout the day.
